



He enjoys being outdoors, loves to hunt and fish when he's not working, and helping his dad out on our hobby farm.


Andrew has his own beef cattle and showed poultry at our county fair.

Makayla is a freshman and stays busy in volleyball, choir and the band where she plays the clarinet.



New baby cousin cuddles




She likes to spend time with family, loves relaxing in her hammock, swimming, movies, music, reading books and is very techy.






### Kurt's Family


Kurt has a large family! He has 2 brothers, 1 sister, 6 step siblings, and 5 nieces and nephews.





### Traveling


### Our Home and Neighborhood
