When we thought about adoption, we never in a million years expected that a pregnancy loss would be a part of our adoption story. We found out that I was pregnant in October 2019 and were shocked when we saw the test. We were overjoyed and so excited. I took three tests just to make sure. When we went to our second appointment, we were told that our sweet baby had an irregular heartbeat and they wanted to send us to perinatology. We were not worried yet as we did not think it was anything major since doctors said there is a chance it could fix itself. We went to the appointment and were referred to pediatric cardiology and we immediately knew something was wrong. For weeks on end it was appointments between these two departments and hearing consistently that our baby would likely not make it to full term and if he or she did their chance at life were slim. We

were heartbroken and devastated but we did what we always do. "Palms Up" is a term we live by in our home. It simply means we release it to Jesus. This was an extremely rare condition and none of it made since to doctors since we were young and heathy. We gave it to God we surrounded our baby with love and prayed daily that Gods hand would be in this. At 14 weeks we went back home to Idaho and had a gender reveal party. We found out we were having a boy. We decided to name him Everette Michael Robert Kidwell. Everette after Jacob and his great Grandpa. Michael after me and my dad, Robert after my brother and Grandpa. We continued going to appointments and these were consistently up and down. Our boy fought hard. We had a worship night at church where we were surrounded by our friends from small group, our pastors, and even strangers. We all prayed that God would heal Everette. We left it at the foot of the cross that night and Jacob prayed to him the following morning telling him "if you need to go buddy we understand, and we will always love you." I prayed a similar prayer and both of us had not shared that with each other. A few weeks later a group of missionaries came through and stayed with us on their way to Mexico. They were prayer warriors and asked if they could pray for me and Everette. They prayed that I would have a healthy safe pregnancy and that God would protect our hearts. The day before they came back on February 25, 2020 we had and appointment. We looked up at the ultrasound screen we had learned where to look for his sweet little heartbeat and we did not see it. The nurse left quickly to get the doctor and we already knew. At 22w and 5d our sweet Everette had no heartbeat. Later that night I began having contractions and was admitted labor and delivery. Everette was born at 12:19 PM February 26, 2020. It is amazing how you can feel so much joy and sorrow in one breath. Sorrow that we lost our first baby but Joy that he was in the arms of Jesus and no longer suffering. This was a hard time for us, but we know that God is in control and has a plan for our future. Everette was not here long but he brought us closer as a family and to God. He has changed the lives of so many and we are proud that he made us parents. He will forever be in our hearts and we cannot wait to be reunited with him one day.
