OUR HOME & PETS

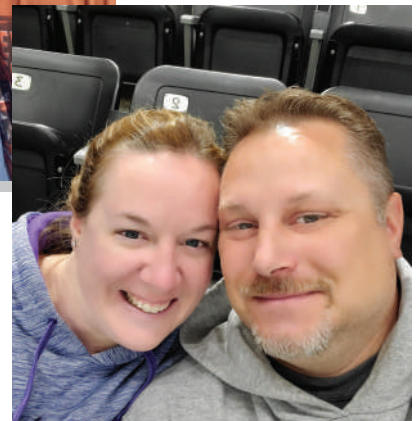
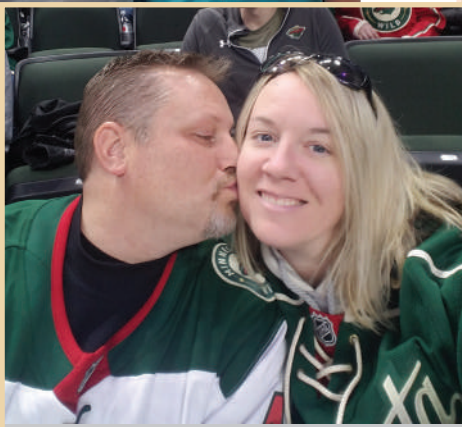
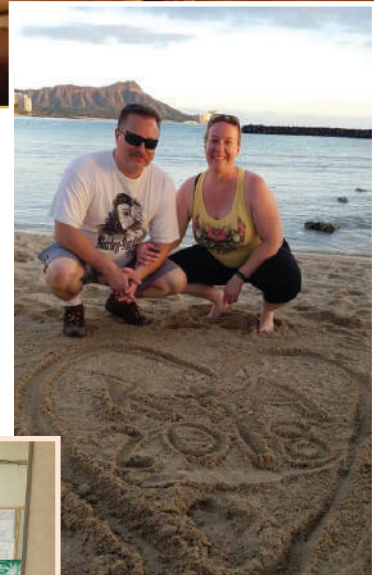
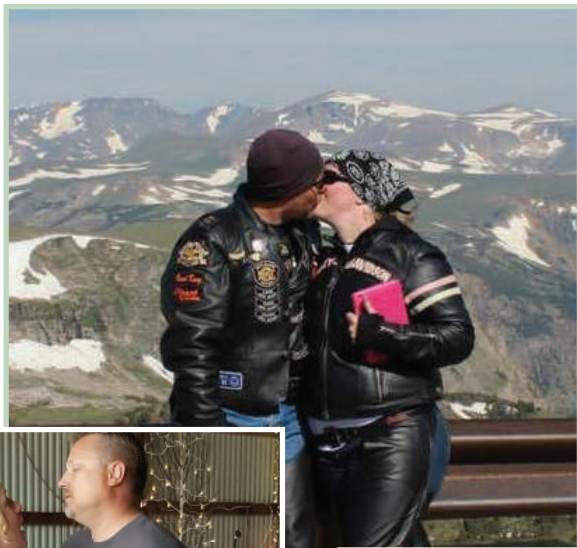
