I hope you will read through my profile and I pray for God to show you and to give you perfect peace of your choice of placement. (And thank you for choosing life!)




# Tracy from Georgia

- I love to laugh and be silly.




## My Beloved Twins - Former Fosterers - *I Found My Life When I Laid It Down*
