Life is so much better surrounded by those you love.

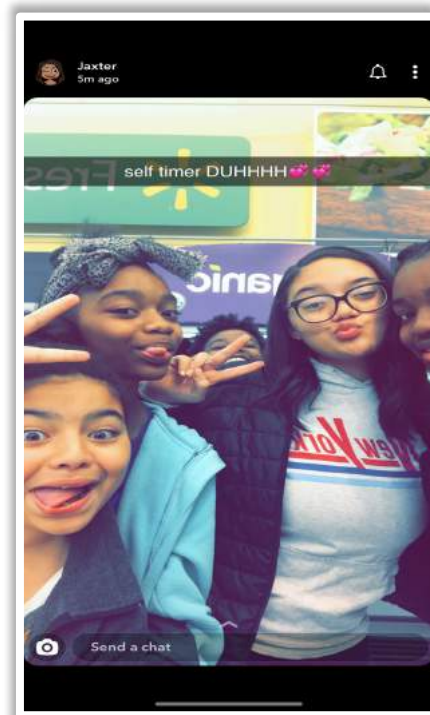


Fun facts about me
