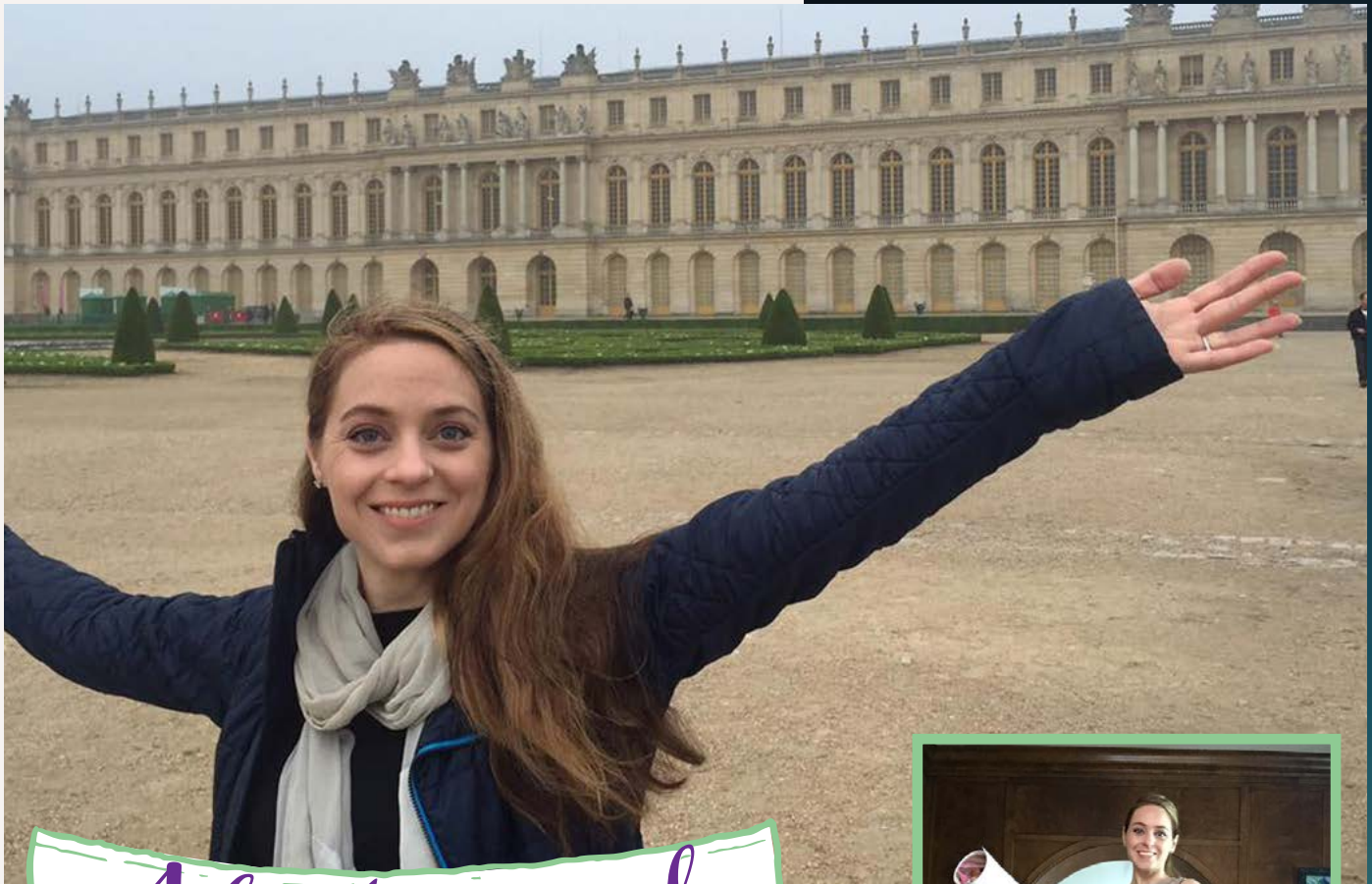




About Scott
