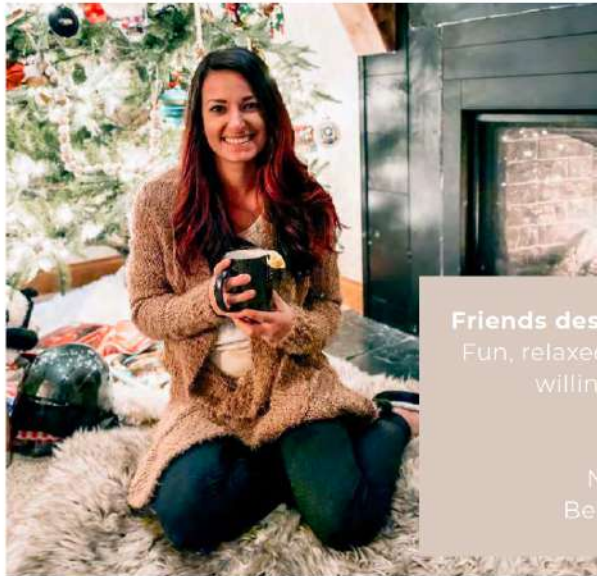
why we are ADOPTING

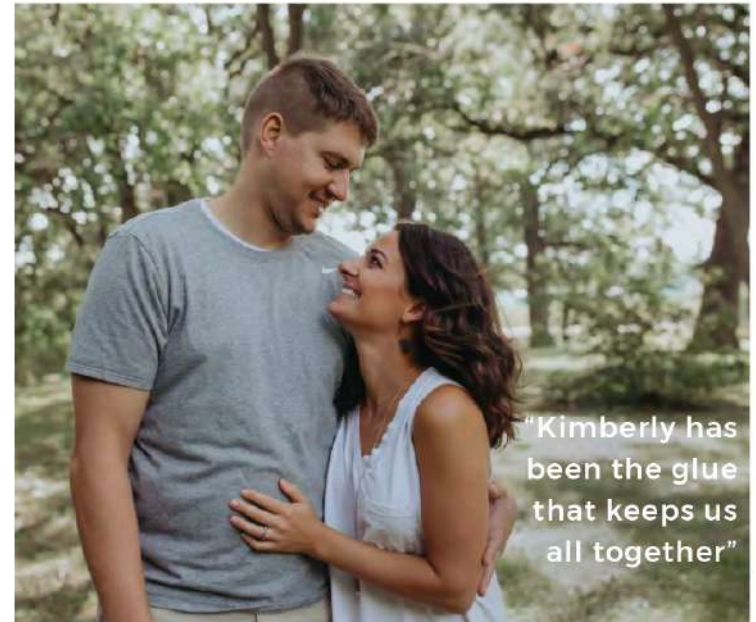
