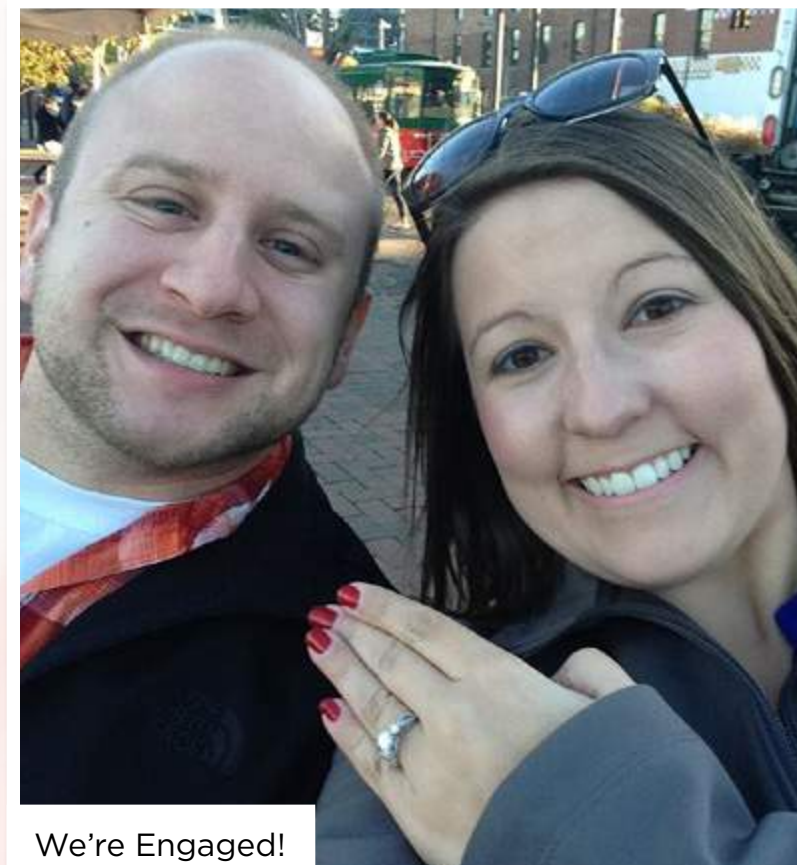


Celebrating our anniversary

We have always dreamed of being parents but had some fertility challenges along our journey. Those challenges taught us how strong we are and how deep our desire to become parents is.



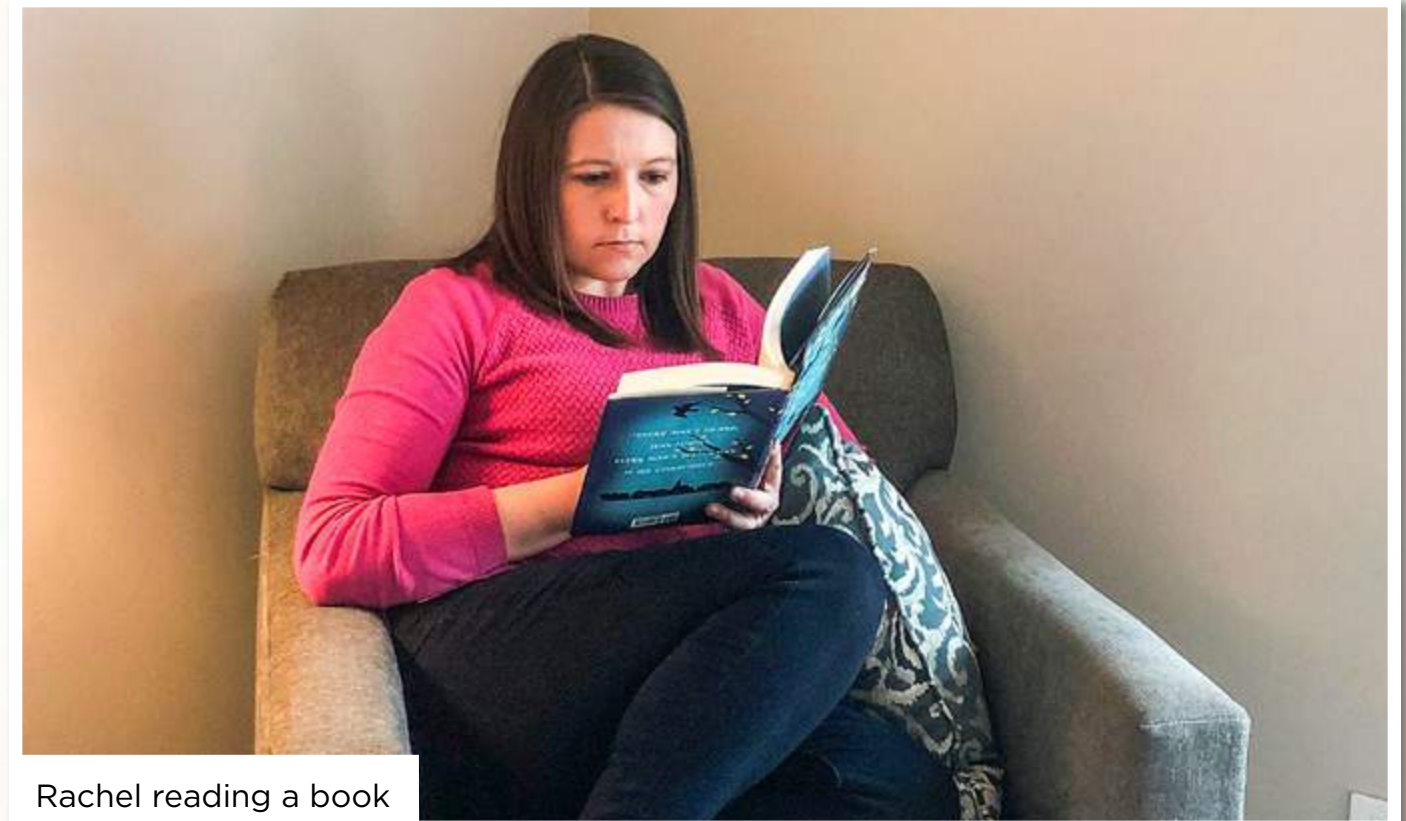
We're Engaged!

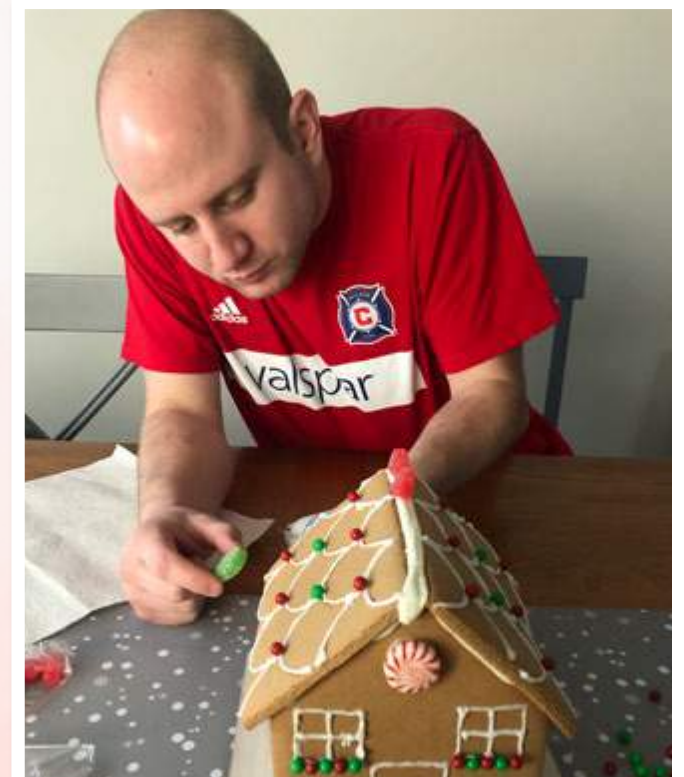

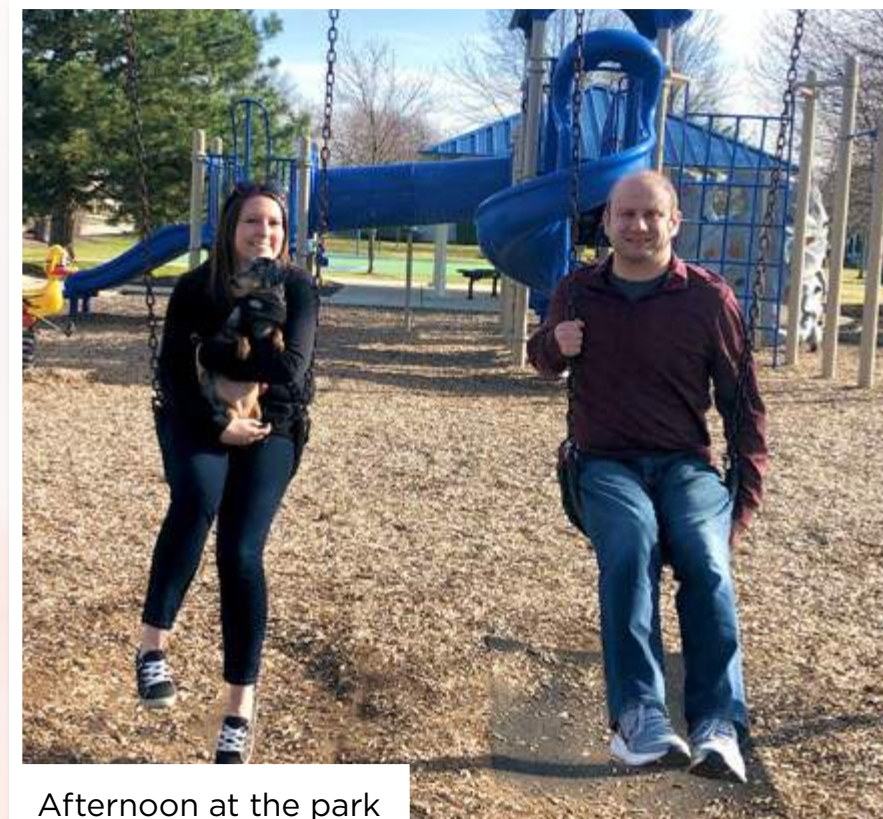

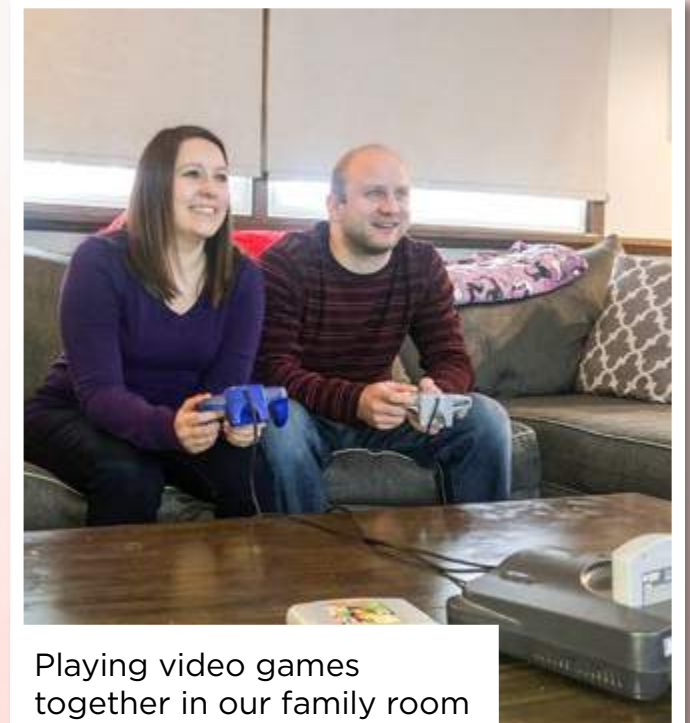
