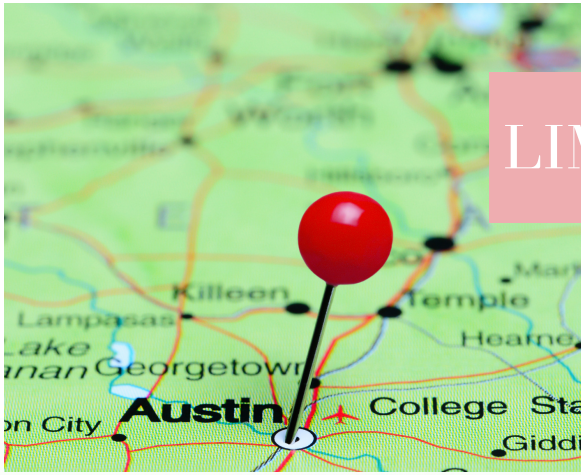
YOU HAVE TO STOP WAITING, IT'S NOW OR IT'S NEVER..

TOO RISKY!

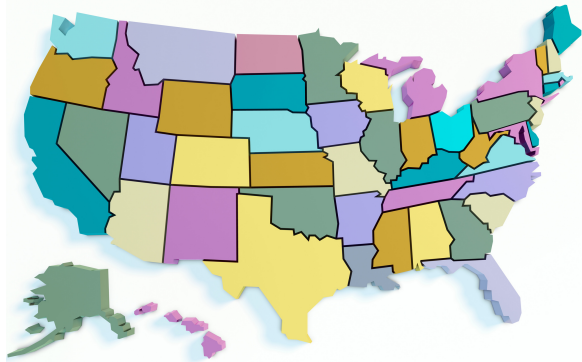
You should not concentrate all efforts and resources on one agency or industry professional, don't risk everything, as one could lose everything.

Don't limit yourself - when you can have Nationwide access...

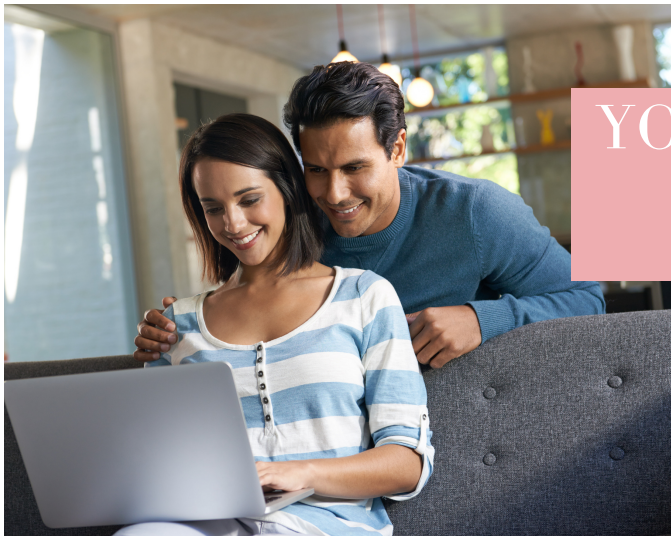
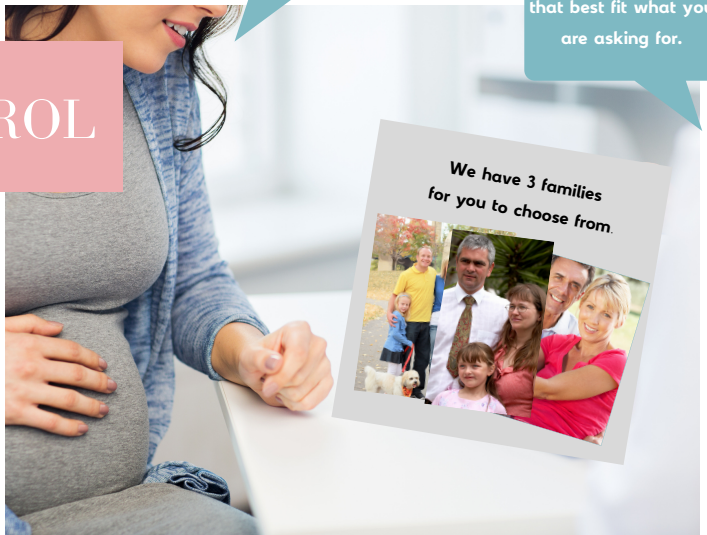
