We DO NOT attempt to influence the outcomes of adoptions or final decisions made between the women and families that connect through our services.

At AFMC, we recognize the ever-expanding digital world and the need for secure, on-demand services. We created the Instant Profile Submission (IPS) System with this in mind. We provide industry professionals, adoptive families, and expectant parents with services tailored to their specific needs.

Adoption profiles are available instantly through our IPS System, helping to find the right family that fits exactly what an expectant parent is requesting. Our IPS system delivers profiles to the requesting expectant/birth parent(s) and/or industry professional within seconds of the adoptive family's submission. Profiles, letters and videos sent through our IPS system can be viewed on ALL mobile devices.



FREE Resources

We can provide expectant/birth mothers with resources to access:

Medical care, shelter, food, maternity clothes, counseling, and more to ensure the wellbeing and safety of her and her child.

Women who receive these resources while pregnant are **NEVER** required to give their child up for adoption.



FINDING THE RIGHT FAMILY

AFMC understands that expectant/birth parent(s) are not just looking for any family that will give their child a wonderful life. They are searching for the *right* family. A family that has all the qualities they want for their child, whom they feel comfortable with, and can trust to raise their child.

Finding the right family that fits exactly what an expectant/birth parent is requesting is a key service for an adoption professional. This is often a difficult task, as they are limited to the families that have signed with them.

Talking to a family does not commit you to anything. An adoption can only legally take place after the baby is born and you've given your consent. You are never obligated to place your child for adoption and you should ALWAYS do what is right for you and your baby! Whether you choose to place your child for adoption (or decide to parent) is completely your decision. You are in control from the start!

What to Expect

There are two ways to view families through our services

1.

Register for a FREE account to message families directly through AFMC's site while remaining anonymous.

2.

Fill out our intake form to receive family profiles straight to your inbox or phone.

RECEIVE PROFILES INSTANTLY - Our IPS System delivers adoption profiles, videos, and letters from adoptive families that want to be considered. You are able to review the information on any device, allowing you the time and privacy you deserve.



We recommend that you choose a few families to "interview" by phone to make sure there is a connection before moving forward. This allows you to connect with them on a more personal level. This is optional. You don't have to do anything you are uncomfortable with.



Once you've chosen a family, start creating a relationship. Talking on the phone, texting or exchanging emails is a good first step in getting to know each other. If meeting in person before the baby is born is an option, it can make things easier and less uncomfortable.





AFMC requested feedback on my experience with the services they provide. I didn't receive a guide on the type of feedback they requested, so I compiled my experiences overall.

I have been exploring family profiles for weeks on multiple platforms. AFMC provided more options for connections than the other platforms I was viewing. AFMC has an option where you send them your specific request and they will send family that meet that request.

Choosing that option was surprisingly much easier for me and eliminate families that didn't meet my requirements. I found that the profile content was very informative which gave me a better view of the family and the lifestyle each presented. On a positive note, it was hard to choose because there were so many great families that presented profiles for me to review. I chose a family that from a visual stand point, I would have never picked, but because they took the time to send their profile, and a personal letter, I took the time to view and read. After reading and viewing the content they provided in their profile, I knew I needed to contact them. Thanks AFMC for allowing this service for all mothers considering adoption. Much easier than I expected.

AFMC, Thank you for providing this option for women. It allowed me space to explore my options. This option also gave me a scene of peace that I wasn't ignoring families that continually messaged with their desperate plea for me to choose them. That may be something to consider posting for families. One platform I was using allowed families to message me after I reached out to them. Which is completely fine, but some families abused this by messaging repeatedly which made them look desperate and a little crazy. It made me feel like prey. You have amazing clients and I really like the platform and program you have put together.

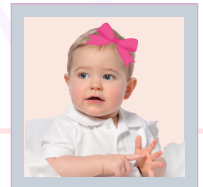




My name is Gina, I placed my baby up for adoption in June of 2019. I'm deaf and my partner is also deaf. Our little girl had a 50/50 chance of being deaf. I have a genetic condition but her father doesn't which means the doctors were not sure if she would be deaf or not. We wanted her to grow up with a family that is fluent in ASL. It was hard walking into an adoption agency and no one being able to help. I was in a Facebook group with other moms who placed their babies up for adoption when one of them referred us to AFMC. I messaged AFMC and told them about us being deaf. Amy responded with information about their services and a list of 2 different ASL caseworkers we could use during our journey. It was a relief being able to view video's from families communicating with us using ASL and reading profile information. Thanks to the services of AFMC we were able to find the perfect family for our daughter. The family we chose has taught her ASL so we all can communicate without having a translator.

As for my pregnancy and my babies adoption, everything's going great with her. She's growing and thriving here.

I will say my pregnancy was very hard, I had no emotional attachment to my pregnancy I'm not afraid to admit that. My body was on survival mode and luckily I was able to survive the situation as well as give her a life. I choose an adoption.

I will say that during my pregnancy I received no prenatal care. I didn't go to the doctors at all, I didn't know how far along I was in my pregnancy. I would drowned out the pain I was dealing with with alcohol and different drugs.



I know it was not the right thing to do for her now, but during that time it was the right thing to do for me. I'm not proud of that.

I chose to have a closed adoption, I didn't want to visit my past at all. The family that I chose respected my decision and have shared pictures through Shutterfly with my old caseworker in case I ever decided I wanted to see her. I've never seen her pictures, but I do have the login and password to the account in case I decide to change my mind. I have asked how she is doing and I hear she is thriving and doing well.

I hope that this help someone out there who needs it. There's always help. I've learned that the hard way but I'm making the right changes for myself and I gave a better life to my daughter.
