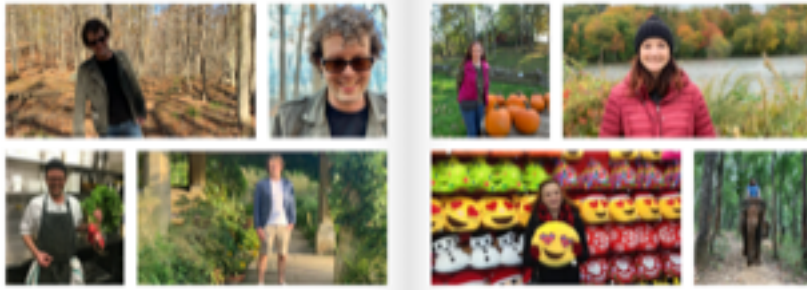
I know how much Kara looks forward to becoming a mom. Kara will allow this child to grow into his or her own person with guidance and support. I am so lucky to have her in my life.
