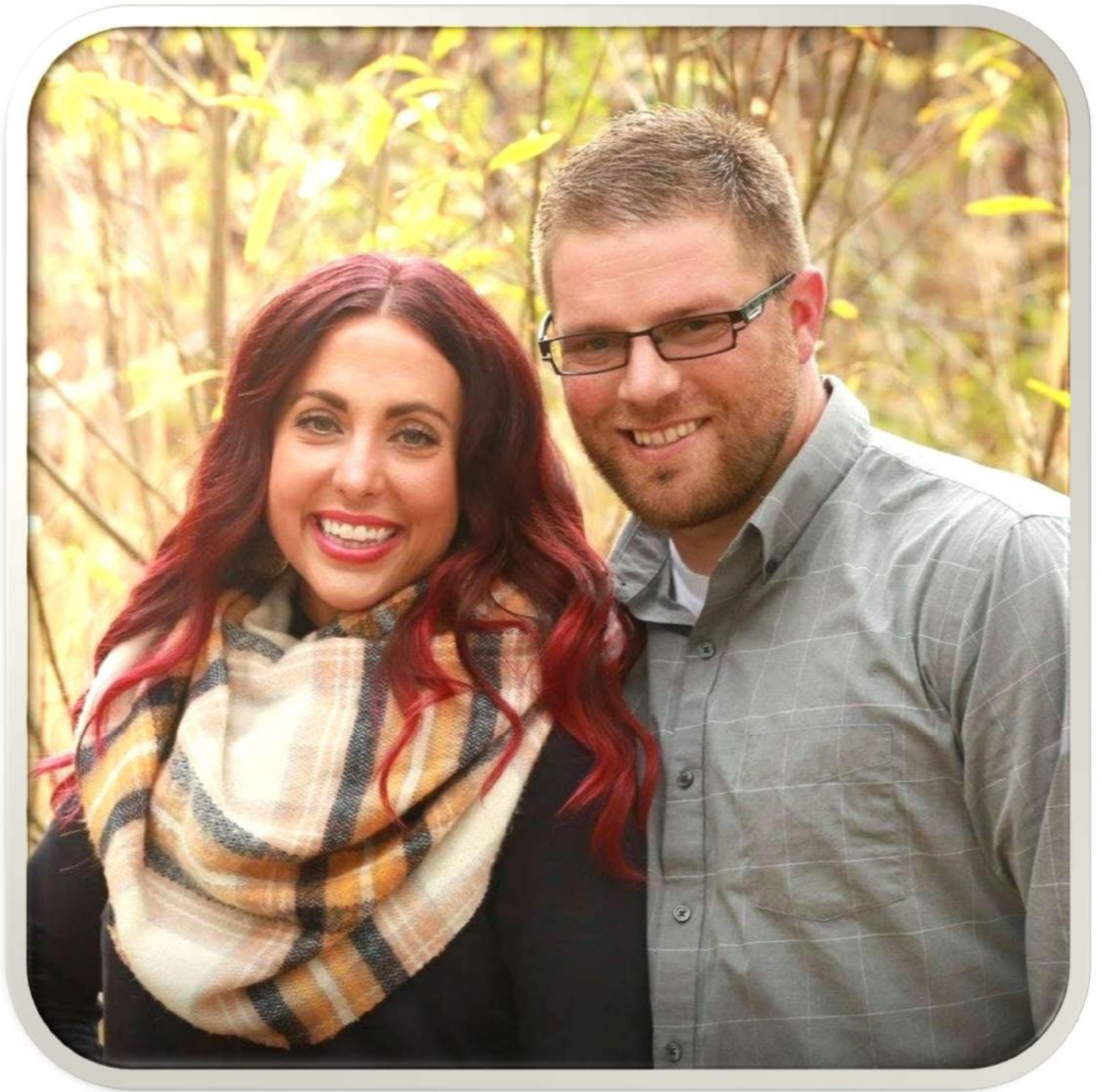




Nicole & Kurtis Koch

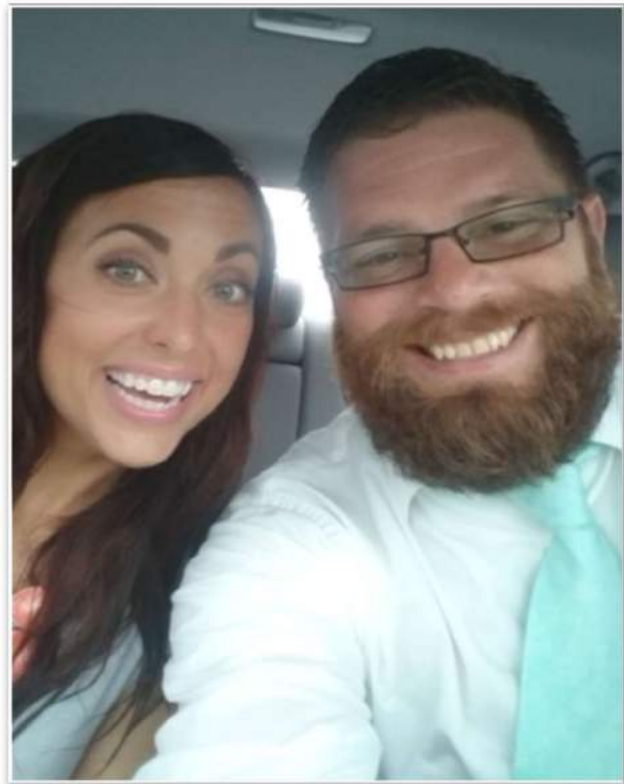
This is Us.

We like to think of ourselves as loving, intelligent, responsible, and funny people and, unless our friends and family have been lying to us, we are not far from the mark.

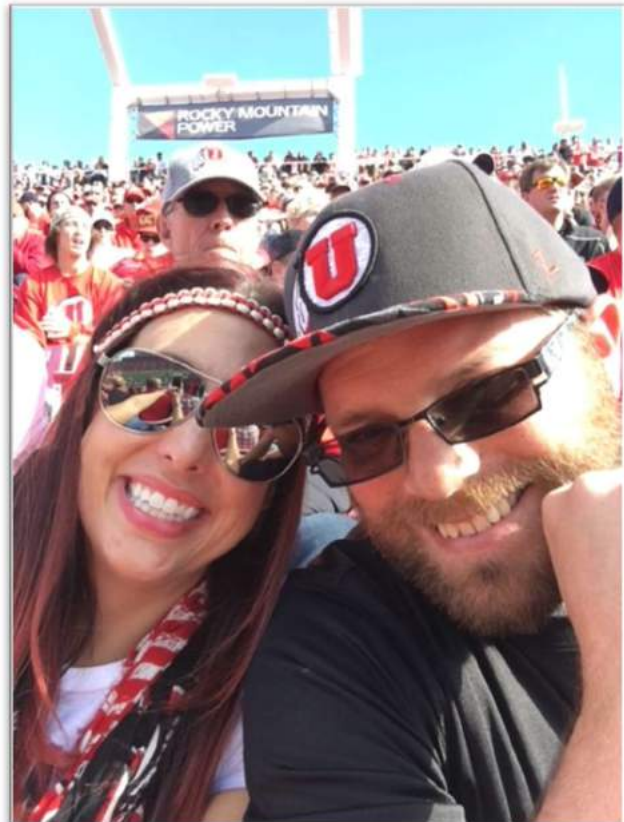
Humor is our superglue. We know the best way for us to stay connected throughout the week is with humor and thoughtful gestures.

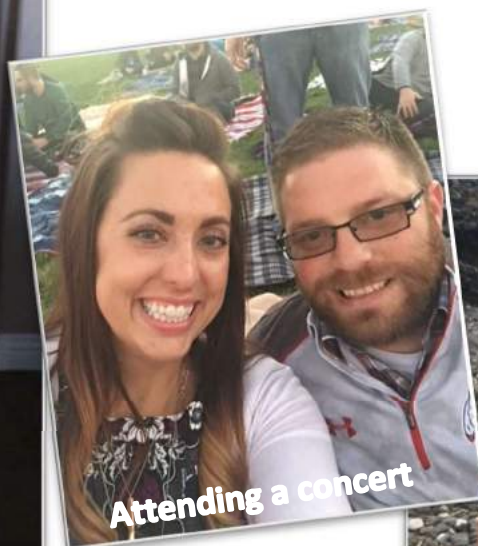

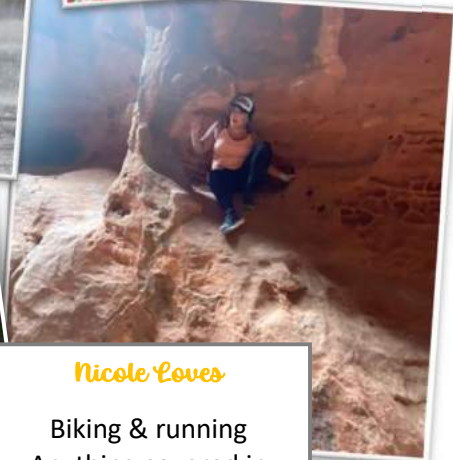
MEET NICOLE

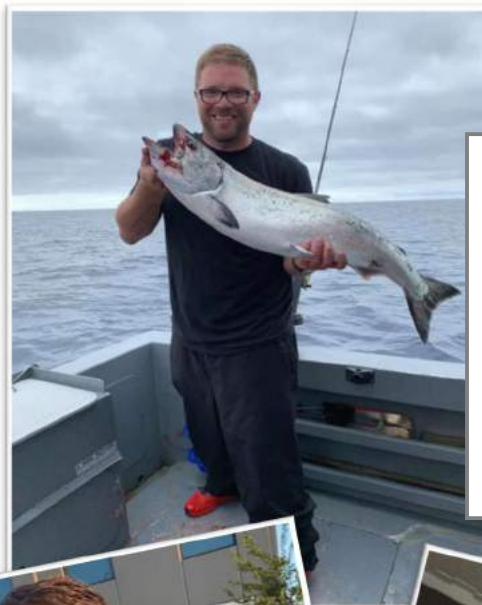
