




We have two children, Flint age 7, and Leo age 5. They are both big goofballs who to love to tell jokes and mkes each other laugh.








We both come from big families. Morgan is the youngest of five and Kari is 6th of seven. With 30+ cousins our kids have a blast any time we get together with our families.
