We have a semi-open adoption with both Gabe and Jameson's birth family, with frequent communication and visits. Tristan's birth family chose a closed adoption, but after his birth reached out occasionally and we were happy to have them in his life. We look forward to welcoming you and your baby into our family in whatever way you would like.

OUR LITTLE crew




Gabe is our spunky, kind, and inquisitive son.




OUR COMMUNITY

We were blessed to be chosen to be Tristan's parents and more blessed to be able to be in the delivery room when he was born. Adam even got to cut the cord with permission from Tristan's birth parents. Due to a heart defect, he had open heart surgery at only nine days old. Tristan was a fighter and we were released to go home a little over a week later! In January of 2022, we took him to the hospital for respiratory distress and unfortunately, he only continued to get worse. Ultimately, due to complications from blood clots, Tristan passed away at just 5 months old.

The single greatest experience with Down syndrome that we have is with our son, Tristan. We learned hands-on about heart defects, open heart surgery, feeding tubes, breathing tubes, oxygen monitoring, Early Access, all the therapies cardiology, hospital visits, check-ups, inclusion and more.

We wish, more than anything, that he was still here with us. We are so grateful to have experienced Tristan's never-ending love and joy. He taught us patience, bravery, strength, and most importantly, love. Tristan was not with us on Earth for very long, but he made a big, life-changing impact and will live on in our hearts and watch over us as our angel forever.
