We moved just outside of Nashville in 2016, so our kids can grow up near cousins, aunts, uncles and grandparents.


We adopted our son John as a newborn in June of 2019. Our marriage has grown even stronger since we became parents together. We are so excited to grow our family again!




OUR FAVORITE THINGS




THANK YOU...

> There will always be a place for you in this child's life, and in ours.


