

Elijah Justus








- Elijah has the sweetest heart, he's kind and sensitive, and he loves to laugh.

- As a homeschooling family, we are able to have a lot of time available to us to give the kids life experiences and different opportunities.
- After 9 years of being a teacher, Becca knew that she did not want the kids to go to school all day long just to come home and do more homework.
- We wanted them to have time to enjoy family time and pursue their interests.
- By homeschooling, the kids do roughly 2-3 hours of school each morning, plus some family chores, and then the days are available to enjoy other activities. They still have normal summer, fall and winter breaks.
- We live in a city that has a huge homeschooling population, and because of that, there are a large array of options for our kids to enjoy.
- Kenley and Elijah both take weekly engineering, art, music and drama classes for homeschoolers.
- They also do a weekly physical education class for homeschoolers where they swim for an hour and play PE games for an hour.
- Our community offers archery, horseback riding, vet tech classes, baking classes, sewing classes

- and so much more geared toward our homeschool kids.
- Because most of our friends are homeschoolers, we set up a lot of times with them throughout the week to go to the zoo, the creek, mini golf, the farm, the trampoline park, a playdate at each other's houses, and the list goes on. - Our kids have lots of friends and are learning a lot of life experiences.
- We have so many activities close by and we like to give the kids a wide range of experiences.

- We believe it's important for our children to grow up with sweet memories and traditions.
 We want them to feel celebrated and also to learn how to enjoy celebrating other people and traditions. We want this for your baby, too.
- For the kids' birthdays, they get to pick whether
 we take an overnight trip somewhere or have a
 party with friends. They also pick the theme,
 cake, and what they want to do that day. We like
 to make their birthdays something where they
 are reminded once again how loved and
 cherished they are.
- Within our home, we have some game nights, movie nights and sometimes the kids "make dinner" for the family (with a lot of help!). We find it important that they learn how to measure out ingredients, use creativity, improvise, plan ahead, follow directions, and think of others while making a meal for the family.
