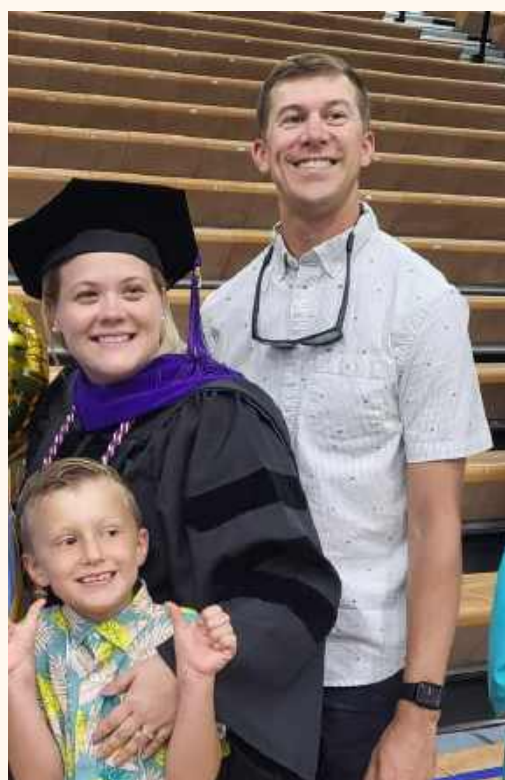
GET TO KNOW *Us*

How we met and fell in love

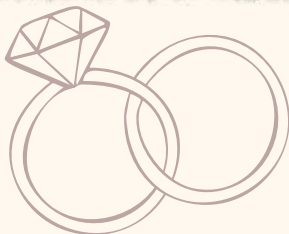


WHERE IT ALL BEGAN
