# Meet Isaiah

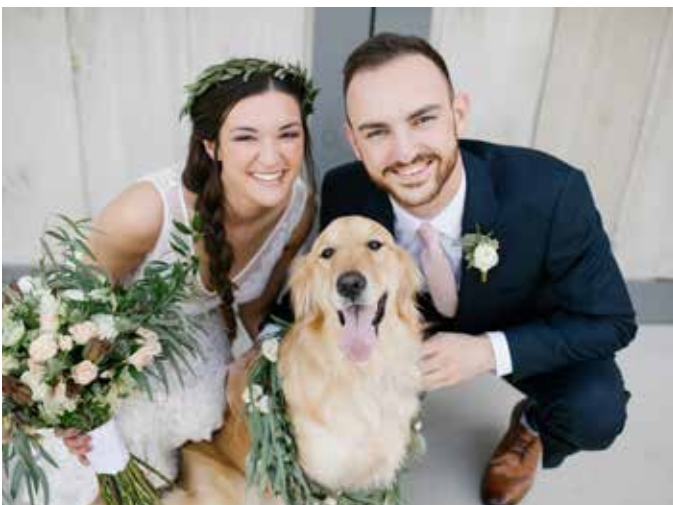

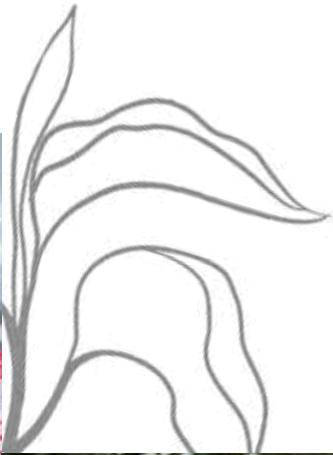

## Fletcher's family

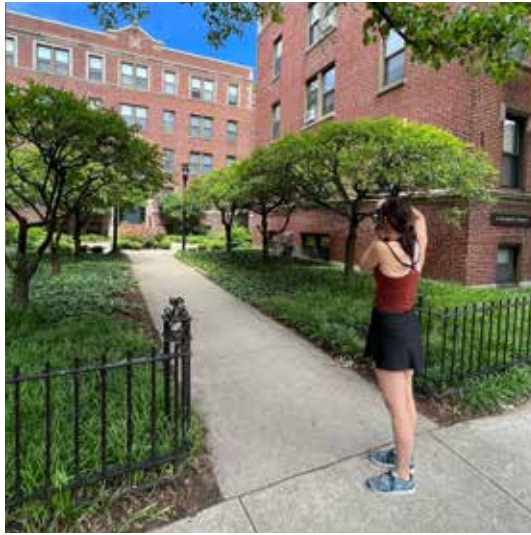
