Why we are adopting

# Meet Meredith



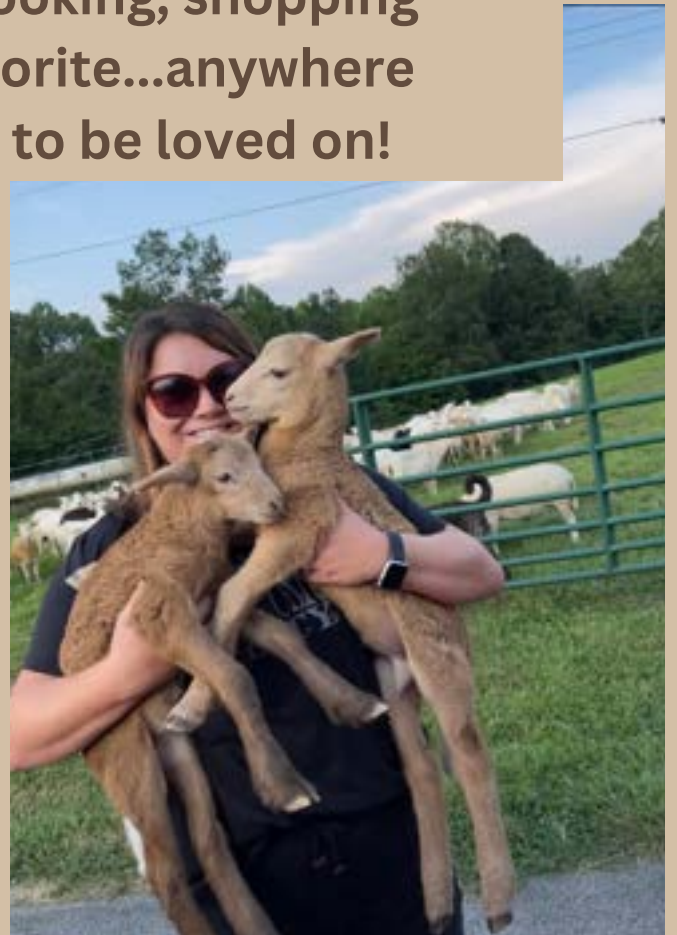
In Jordan's eyes:

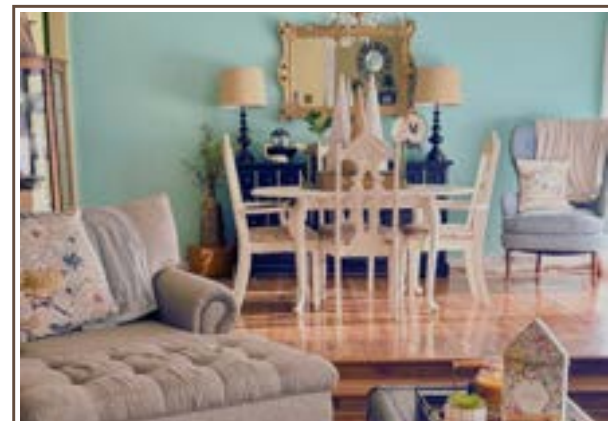


# Our Home

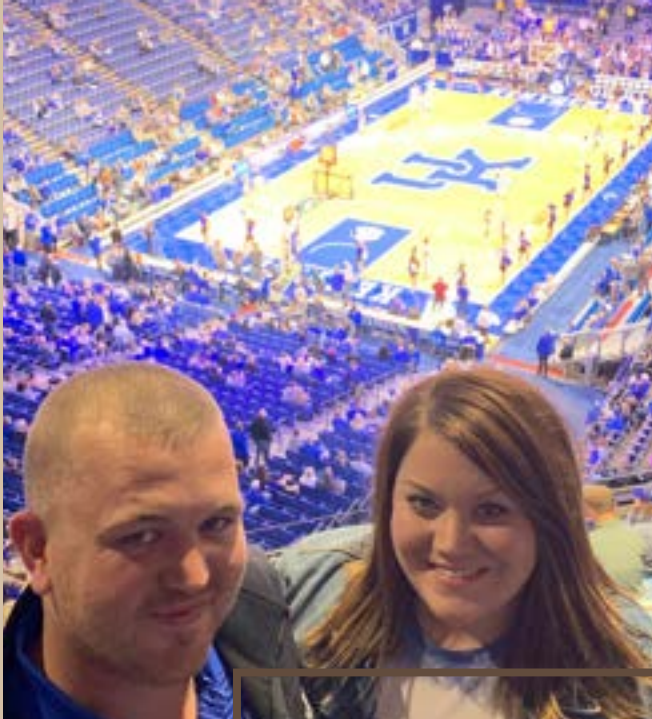
