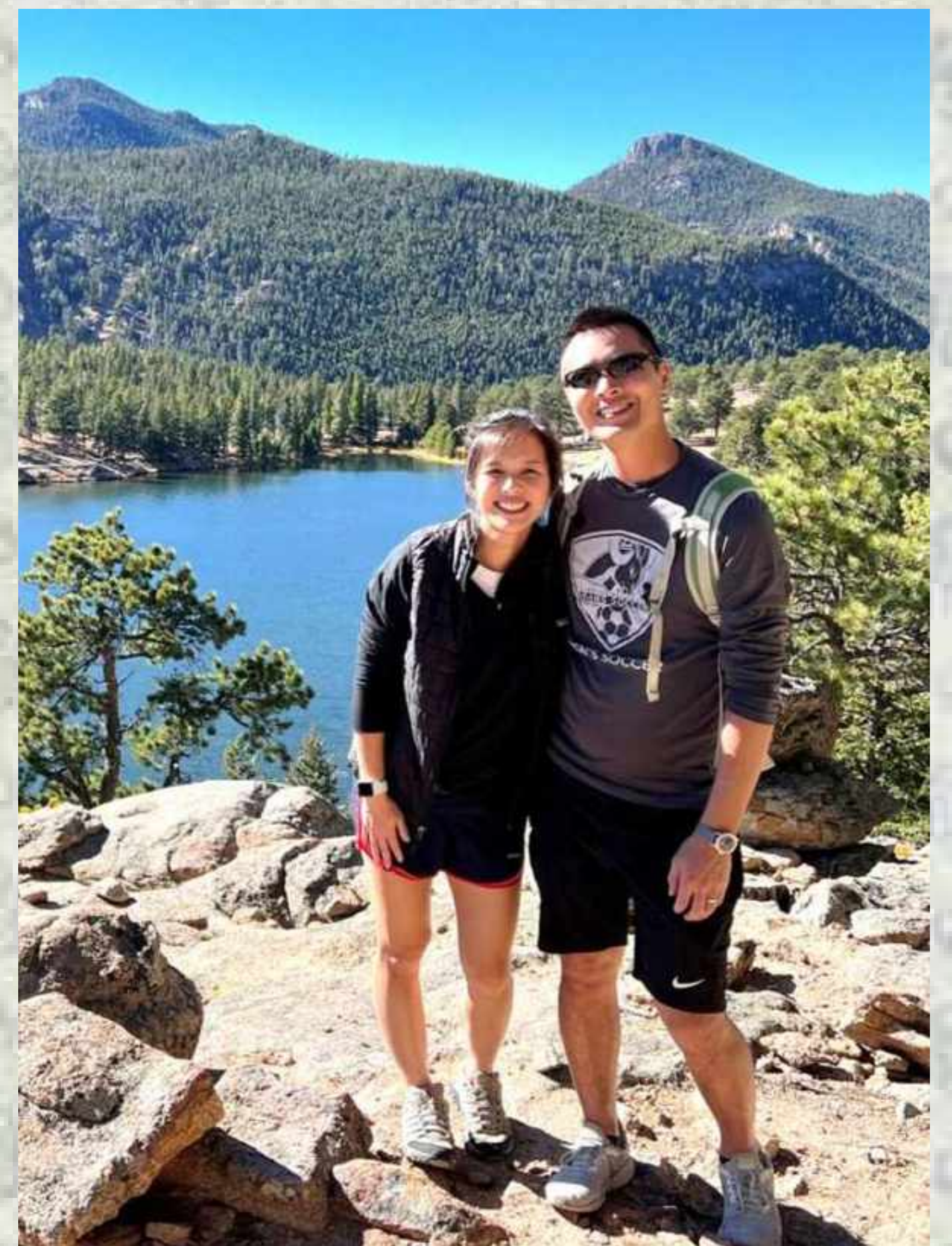


WHY ADOPTION?
