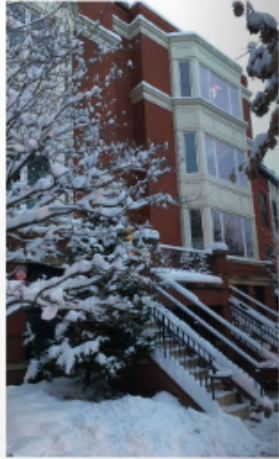
Adam's Family...

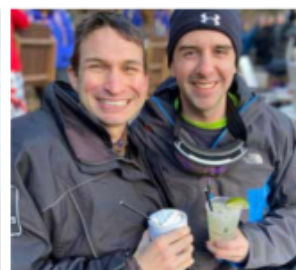
